

- A "law for the acceleration of renewable energy" was enacted to simplify procedures, and shorten the deadlines for renewables. The implementing decrees are currently under discussion.
- Decrees include
 - Obligations to solarise car parks
 - Definition of agrisolar framework
 - Value sharing.

✓ FiT S6-S10: end of re-negotiation procedure




Gigafactory projects and a solar pact for industry

- In line with the Green Industry Act adopted in October 2023, a solar pact is being discussed between the industry and the government to speed up the solar industry's re-industrialisation.
- This pact represents a mutual commitment between the French government and solar industry in supporting the development of industry in France across the entire value chain and developing exemplary projects from a technological, social and environmental point of view.




The French Market per Segment






The French solar market - Quarterly installed capacity

- Solarisation decree for car parks to be published in Q1 2024
- Agrivoltaics decree to be published in early 2024
- Pending publication of few FiT decrees
 - ground-mounted projects <1MW
 - and 500kW overseas regions

Going further to achieve the national targets set by the MAEP

- Clarify and simplify administrative procedures
- Stabilizing support mechanisms
- Support European solar panel manufacturers
- Alleviate labour shortages
